

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The Jaswant Rai Memorial Library of the college is the core of academic services, and therefore, become a key place in academic and research activities. Library has fully air-conditioned reading section with capacity of 100 students, separate electronic library, separate reading section for teachers, fully automation with KOHA ILMS. With its collection of more than 33000 text books, 4090 reference books, 609 CDs/DVDs, 21 Print journals, 25 Magazines/Periodicals, 7 different newspapers, it provides the ready to use information support to its users. Besides printed books and journals, central library collection includes thousands of e-Books, e-journals and open access e-resources.
