The Jaswant Rai Memorial Library of the college is the core of academic services, and therefore, become a key place in academic and research activities. Library has fully air-conditioned reading section with capacity of 100 students, separate electronic library, separate reading section for teachers, fully automation with KOHA ILMS. With its collection of more than 35K books, it provides the ready to use information support to its users. Besides printed books and journals, central library collection includes e-Books, e-journals and open access e-resources. CELEBRATION OF IMPORTANT DAYS

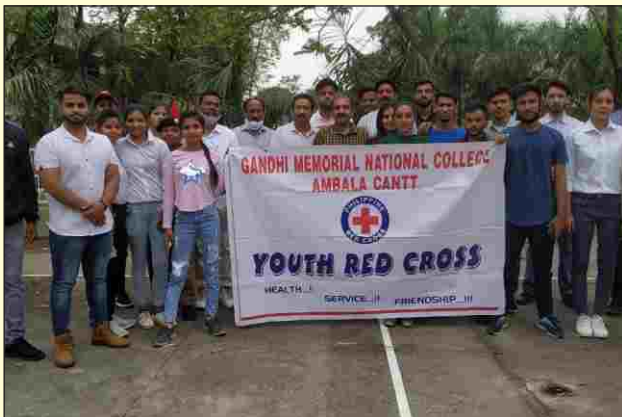
(2020-2021)

WOMEN CELL

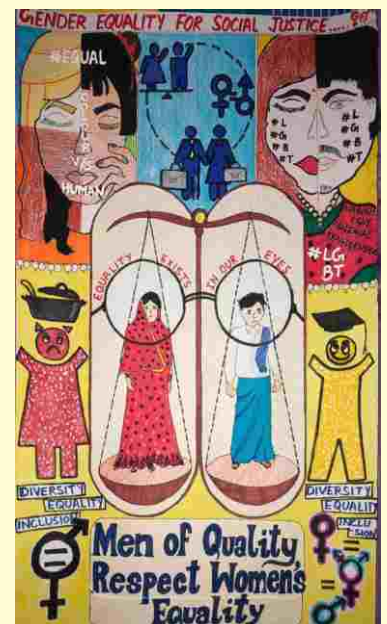

She said that though both these art forms had certain connections and differences, they had a similarity of taking the readers/audience to a different world.
