W.D.R.C, K.U.K. It was organized by **Sexual Harassment Committee** on 18 Aug. 2018.

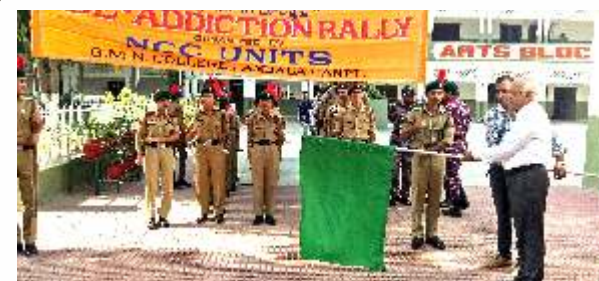
